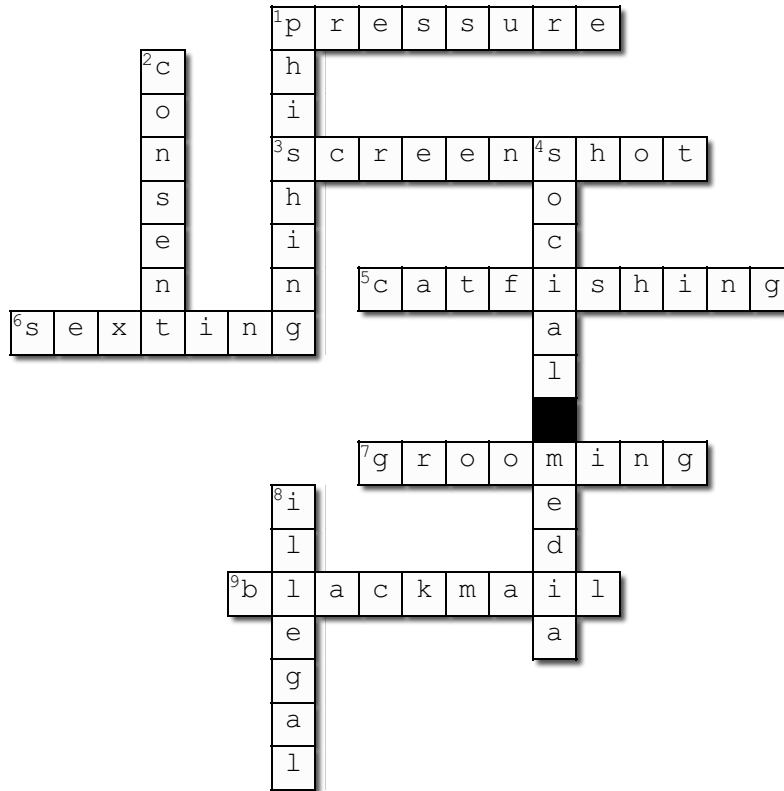


Complete the crossword puzzle below
